Choir is practicing each Thursday at 5:30. Please note, this could change according to Carissa's schedule.

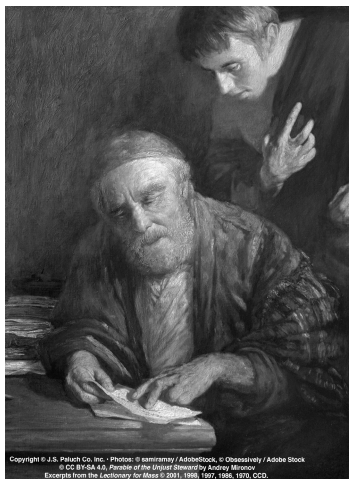
